Your child must have:

- Transportation home.
- A completed audition form.

Each child should be prepared to sing and read lines from *Jungle Book Kids*. Students should see Mr. Durland for audition materials. Memorization is encouraged but not required.

Please note that auditions are closed to the public.

Parents will not be permitted to sit in on the auditions.

Parts will be assigned at our first rehearsal on Wednesday, December 4th.

Rehearsals will be held after school on various Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays in the auditorium. A detailed rehearsal schedule will be sent home on Wednesday, December 4th. Please consider your child's schedule carefully.

Our first rehearsal for the entire cast is after school on Wednesday, December 4th. Parents are required to attend a mandatory parent meeting in person at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, December 4th.

There will be a \$20.00 participation fee for this activity.


